

COPLEY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEE REGULAR MEETING

MONDAY, DECEMBER 11, 2006

President Scott Dressler convened the regular meeting of the Copley Township Board of Trustees at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, December 11, 2006.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

WELCOME GUESTS

Trustee Dressler asked for Service Director Mark Mitchell to introduce the newest employee to his department. Mr. Mitchell introduced Andrew Sattler who was hired to replace Assistant Service Director Doug Miller due to Mr. Miller's recent promotion. All in attendance welcomed Mr. Sattler to the Township.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Fiscal Officer requested approval of the minutes from the Regular Meeting held November 27, 2006. Motion by Trustee Panovich; second by Trustee Humphrys; all voting aye.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT

1. Requested approval to advance \$3,000.00 from #1000 General Fund to #2181 Zoning Fund for payroll through December 1, 2007.

With this reappropriation, and with transferring all other unencumbered appropriation balances to the payroll accounts, I estimate that payroll will still be short by approximately \$25,000.00.

- Certificate of Estimated Resources has Police District as having \$2,399,521.61 available to appropriate of which all was appropriated through the Permanent Appropriations in March 2006.
- As of 11/30/06, the Police District has collected \$2,342,731.36 and had a carry-over of \$15,981.61 for a total of \$2,358,712.97. The difference between what has been expected to be available and what is to be actually available is \$40,808.64. Of that difference, nothing has been collected as of December 8, 2007. Called the Summit County Fiscal Office; can expect about \$5,000.00 in December for Personal Tangible Exempt payment. May need to amend the certificate down to reflect actual receipts.
- The amount that has been encumbered to date but not paid is \$90,969.05 of which approximately \$48,000.00 worth of invoices have been received and are due to be paid before year-end. The remaining open Purchase Orders have been reviewed and are needed to support operations through January 2007, however, some may be able to be closed if necessary.
- Dispatchers' payroll is divided among the departments according to a percentage breakdown that had previously been adopted whereby Police was to absorb 40% of the cost; Fire 23%; Service 11%; and the General Fund 26%. Currently, the Dispatchers payroll has been distributed to change the percentages to Police 33%; Fire 26%; Service 11% and the General Fund 33%.

Requested authorization to amend the Permanent Appropriations for 2006 along with the 2006 Estimated Certificate of Resources to reflect the current receipts.
