MONDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2008

President Helen Humphrys convened the regular meeting of the Copley Township Board of Trustees at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, October 27, 2008.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

WELCOME GUESTS

Trustee Humphrys welcomed Mr. Greg Bachman from the Summit County Engineer's Office along with his Director of Administration Brian Stormer and Chief Deputy Engineer Robert Bunnell. Mr. Bachman presented his annual report for Copley Township outlining the year's accomplishments and ongoing projects highlighting the upgrade and environmental improvements to the Copley maintenance yard on Cleveland Massillon Road at Sawmill. Mr. Bachman answered questions from the audience and the Trustees thanked him for his efforts on behalf of the township.

1. Requested permission to approve the attached agreement with Copley-Fairlawn City Schools for the purchase of salt from the Township. The agreement has previously been reviewed by Legal Counsel, the Service Department and each Trustee and all changes/suggestions have been included.

7. Conducted research on natural gas purchase prices for the township as a result of the quote for \$12.828 per mcf received from Direct Energy for participating in the Summit County aggregation. Signed a contract with Interstate Gas Supply (IGS) for a fixed rate of \$9.29 per mcf beginning December 2008 billing cycle through November 2009.

- 3. Updated Board of Trustees on the huge success of the Halloween Festival. Kiwanis volunteers parking cars had unofficial count of 575 children in costume; Chief Mier thanked the Kiwanis for their generous financial donations and their interest in volunteering for the event.
- 4. Reported on use of new cameras in the Montrose Area to aid a caller reporting an incident of road rage. Dispatch positioned the cameras to keep the caller under surveillance until police could arrive.

Service Department – Service Director Mitchell

- 1. Requested approval of Change Order #1 to the Asphalt Resurfacing project. All the funds encumbered for resurfacing township roads were not used; however, additional funds need to be encumbered to repair the cemetery roads as listed in the project. The change order would not increase the amount of the Purchase order but would move \$17,283.50 encumbered for Fund #2031 to Fund#2041.

Informed Board of Trustees of practices that will be followed if road salt is in short supply as predicted: salt trucks will be recalibrated to use less salt per run, salting will be limited between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. and employees will be trained to use less salt. The Service Department will check into brine applications as well.
- 3. Document Shredding Service will be available for all residents on Saturday, November 1, 2008 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

- 2. Trustee Panovich asked about progress of purchasing lock boxes for Senior Citizens. Chief Benson indicated he was working with Chief Mier to determine the number to purchase at the best price.

- 2. Ms. Spraggins sent a thank you letter to three youth who helped a Copley Township resident resolve an issue with his fence under the direction of Assistant Zoning Inspector Matt Springer. The boys provided the necessary labor to move the fence into zoning compliance.
