

COPLEY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEE SPECIAL MEETING

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2009

The purpose of the meeting was to review the work completed thus far by Mr. Weinstein on the rewriting of the Zoning Resolution. Mr. Weinstein discussed the rationale for combining the current zoning districts into a more manageable number and the criteria used to establish each new district. He presented a chart outlining the current districts and the proposed districts and discussed the informal and formal process he is using to review each of the chapters in the text.

Mr. Weinstein stated he is working with the staff in the Zoning Department to complete the draft and hopes the final draft will be ready soon. All the data will be reviewed with the Zoning Commission at their meeting to be held later that evening and will consider further direction from the commission on the appropriate items.

The Board also briefly discussed the agenda for the JEDD meeting scheduled for December 1, 2009 with the City of Akron.
