**However, there are some toys, such as –
stuffed animals, Barbie dolls, Hot Wheels cars,
Candy Land, Chutes and Ladders, and superhero figures
- that normally we get more than
we know what do with!**

**Character-themed sleeping bags and Snuggies, pillows
and blankets are a big hit with the younger children
(and often a much needed item).**

**Each year we tend to run low in donations of gift items
For newborn infants and those 8-10.**

Some suggestions for the 8-10 age group are –

- **Non-traditional board games (electronic “dating” types of board games are a big hit with the girls)**
- **Remote control vehicles**
- **Construction sets like Legos, Erector, K’Nex, Bionicle...**
- **sporting equipment like, skateboards and bikes**
- **bath, fragrance, hair sets, manicure sets**
- **men’s cologne (Axe, Old Spice and Tag are popular)**
- **jewelry, watches and wallets**
- **sleeping bags and warm, snuggly sacks**
- **socks**
