Executive Session began at 4:10pm.

Trustee Dressler moved to go public at 4:24p.m., second by Trustee Schulte; the motion carried.

Motion - Trustee Koellner move to close the Township facility under the Governor's orders until 11:59 p.m. on May 1. Trustee Dressler second. Roll call: Trustee Dressler, Aye; Trustee Koellner, Aye; and Trustee Schulte, Aye.

Trustee Koellner expressed his thanks to Service Department personnel for completing their assigned project within two days regarding building the trailers as quickly as they did.

Service Director Mark Mitchell thanked Tim Mier for his assistance in the design of the trailer for service personnel to follow. Mr. Mitchell also thanked Trustee Koellner for the loan of his table saw.


Chief Mier raised concerns about the number of people hanging out at the low budget motels clearly in violation of the social distancing requirements. He contacted Summit County Public Health seeking authority to stop the party activity at the motels. Trustee Koellner advised Chief Mier to send his concerns to Summit County's Emergency Operations Center.

With no further business, Trustee Dressler announced the Board will meet in Executive Session in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, April 8 at 1:00 p.m. to discuss employment of personnel in the Community & Economic Development Department.
