**8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.** - The day will begin with a Pancake Breakfast sponsored by the Copley Fire and Rescue Association located at Fire Station 1 at Copley Town Hall, 1540 S. Cleveland-Massillon Road.

All Saturday afternoon events will take place at Copley Community Park.

**12:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m.** - Copley Community Park Family Fun Celebration featuring food, craft, business and non-profit vendors! **THERE IS NO PUBLIC PARKING AT THE PARK WITH THE EXCEPTION OF HANDICAP PARKING.** Handicap parking will be available in the north

parking lot at Copley Park. You will be directed.

There will be a "drop-off" point at the north parking lot for strollers, etc. and for those who are unable to ride the buses. **AFTER "DROP-OFF" YOU WILL HAVE TO PARK IN PUBLIC PARKING LOTS.**

There will be 4 shuttle buses running from 11:45 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Two will pick up at B&W. Two will pick up at Car Parts Warehouse, Hummel Funeral Home, Walterville and Copley Middle School's parking lot on Schoolcraft. Current COVID guidelines recommend wearing masks on the bus and only one person per seat unless related. A limited amount of disposable masks will be available on each bus.

### COVID GUIDELINES

Governor DeWine announced Ohio's existing health orders, including the statewide mask mandate, will be rescinded on June 2. Following this announcement, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued guidance stating anyone who is fully vaccinated can participate in indoor and outdoor activities, large or small, without wearing a mask or physically distancing.

Guidelines for buses: The charter company highly recommends masks while on the bus. Each bus will have a limited amount of disposable masks if you need one. It is recommended one person per seat. If you live in the same residence/group then two per seat.

Guidelines for children: Children under the age of ten may be unmasked and limited to groups of ten.

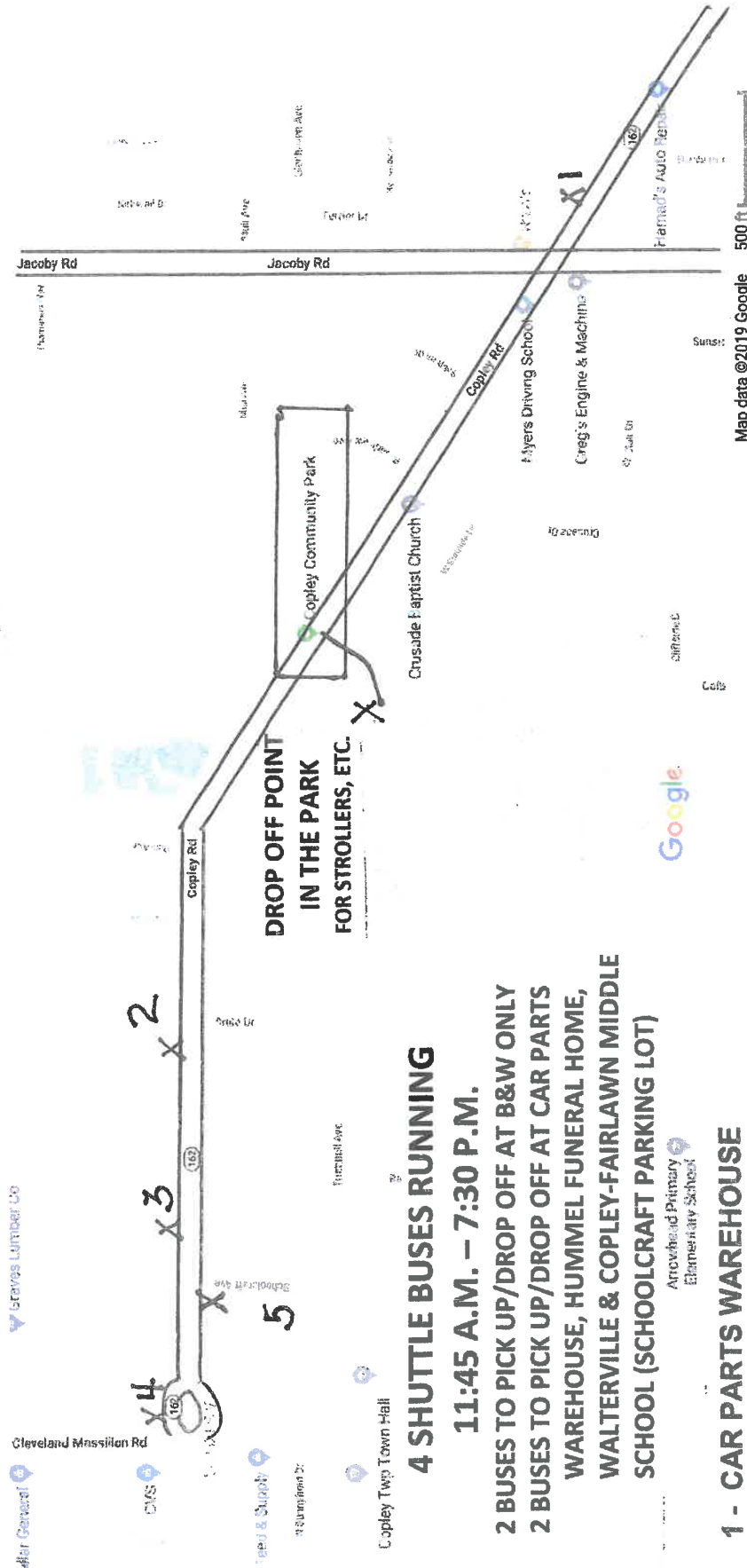

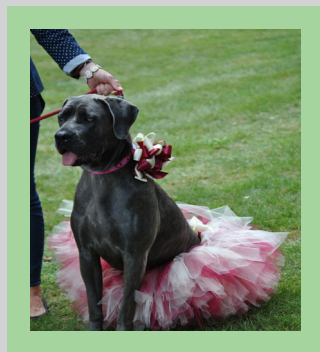
