Technology Updates in Copley Fire Department

Technology has become integral to modern society; almost everyone seems to have a smart phone, tablet or computer they use regularly. Your firefighters and paramedics use those same devices every day before, during and after emergency calls.

Most of our technology is software, replacing paper-based systems for scheduling, reporting, and forms. However, some of our most critical equipment is also high tech. Our ambulances are equipped with Wi-Fi hot spots allowing our heart monitors and Emergency Medical Service (EMS) reporting software to stay connected via cloud computing. Our radios are now mini computers connected to a radio network designed just like a hardened, secure wireless computer network. Even our remote microphones use Bluetooth connections to interface wirelessly with our portable radios.

There are always challenges with new technologies, but the advantages outweigh the costs. Our daily vehicle and equipment checks are recorded electronically, eliminating a cumbersome and paper-laden system which required boxes of papers to be stored for years to comply with public records law.

Our scheduling software connects with all of our employees in real time so they can respond to open shifts and check their schedules anywhere they have an internet connection. They no longer have to come to the station and sign up on yet another piece of paper.

Ultimately, the technology we use is intended to make us more efficient and effective providers of service to you, our customers. Anything we can afford to do that make us better providers of service, we try to do.


