No appointment for interviews is necessary.

FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN AGES 17 AND UNDER will be serviced by the Kiwanis (food), Township (toys) and Outreach Center (coats).

FAMILIES WITH NO CHILDREN UNDER 18 are not eligible for the toy program or Kiwanis Food Program. Service to these families will be provided through the Copley Outreach Center. Call 330-665-3335 for more information.
