RAKE IT OR LEAF IT




THE PROBLEM



When leaves clog our storm drains and enter our waterways, it adds excess nutrients to the water and can cause algal blooms.

- Algal blooms cover the surface of the water and block sunlight.
- The lack of light in the lower layers kills the plants.
- It subsequently affects all the fish and other organisms.
- When the algae eventually decays, the decomposers use up all the available oxygen.
- Creates a "dead zone". 

HOW TO RECYCLE



-  **USE LEAVES FOR MULCH**
Mow over combines leaves and grass clippings.
-  **USE FOR COMPOST**
Combine with nitrogen-rich and carbon-rich materials.
-  **LEAVE FOR SHELTER**
Leaf piles beneath shrubs provide winter protection for beneficial insects.
-  **MAKE LEAF MOLD**
Dampen your leaves and store in any container where air can flow. Allow decomposition.
-  **FALL DECOR**
Simply iron the leaves between wax paper to preserve them.
-  **PROTECT PLANTS**
Insulate delicate vegetation with a thick (six-inch) layer of shredded leaves.

PROPER DISPOSAL



If you have to get rid of your leaves, follow these rules to ensure proper disposal:

- ❌ DO NOT dump leaves in a ravine.
- ❌ DO NOT dump leaves in a riparian zone.
- ❌ DO NOT dump leaves in a conservation zone.
- ❌ DO NOT dump leaves in any body of water.
- ❌ DO NOT burn your leaves.



Check your local county or city for free curbside pickup of bagged or piled leaves.
