



## August Update From the Department of Community & Economic Development

The Department processed 13 zoning applications for a total investment of approximately \$1,197,834.00 in July.

### Capital Projects

- Public Parking Lot
  - The lot is open for public use.
  - The Township is finalizing a punch list of items that include: fencing, signage, and seeding
- **Cleveland-Massillon Sidewalk**
  - The Board of Trustees approved funding for Kenmore Construction to remove the existing sidewalk south of Copley Circle and replace it with a 5-foot walk.
  - Later this month, the Township will move forward with engineering the new sidewalk from Copley Circle to the new connection off of Sunset Drive with Cleveland-Massillon Road.
- **Safety Center/Sunset Drive**
  - The Safety Center drawings are complete and under review by Summit County agencies.
  - Sunset Drive construction drawings are 90% complete and under review as well.
  - Infinity Construction (Copley's Construction Manager At-Risk) will be presenting a guaranteed maximum price or GMP to the Board of Trustees later this month.

### Board Vacancies

- ARB – Two vacancies
- Zoning Commission – Two vacancies,
- BZA – One vacancy
